Dear Sirs,

We take the liberty of approaching you on behalf of the above named, a repatriate who only recently has returned with his wife and son from Russia.

His second son Leonid, University Professor in Chicago has submitted affidavits for his parents and brother, one set of them to Poland, the other to Sweden, so that a Swedish transit visa could be obtained.

Mr. Joseph Bychowski, Chairman of the Committee of Polish Jews in Stockholm informed Mr. Hurwicz that the affidavits and the required guarantee of \$1.000 for each person have been deposited with the Transmigration Committee in Stockholm.

We should be greatly obliged for your kind intervention and assistance in arranging the Swedish transit for this family, as they have the chance of obtaining their American visa very soon.

Our applicants have already received their passports, so that they could leave for Sweden as soon as the Swedish visa is granted to them.
