

The information below is a small part of "20 Years of Kotzin Genealogy research", compiled by Ted (Theodore Joseph) Kotzin and shared with me (Michael Hurwicz) as Ted\_Kotzin\_EXHIBIT4.pdf. At the request of family, I have removed that document and substituted this one, keeping the same document name so that links would not be broken.

1.9.2 Miriam Batsheva married Chazkel Frydland; they moved to Warsaw and had 5 children: Boris, Gitla, Salcia, Helen, Sarah Leah. Chazkel died in Warsaw in 1916; Miriam died in 1912. Chazkel’s father was Abiche (Royole?) from Elrazola (?)

Boris, pharmacist, lived in Shklov, Mogilev Gubernia. His first wife was Sophia Kagan-Szabszaj. They had 2 sons, Misha and Adia (Adolf), who lived in Moscow, and a daughter Vera (?). Boris’ second wife was Abichke Ragoler (the name may refer to an innkeeper ancestor from Aragola); they had a son Gutman who married Hinda ...; they lived in Szancy, near Kaunas and had 3 sons: Adolf, who married Salcia Frydland, Saul, Boka, and 2 daughters: Lina, who married a Mr. Gordon and lived in Melitopol in Crimea, and Raszel.

Gitla, who first married a Mr. Halpern, and then a Mr. Solowieczyk; she seems to have died in Lithuania in 1943 in the Holocaust. She had 1 child by Halpern and 3 children by Solowieczyk:

Bernice, who was Halpern’s daughter and lived with Helen Frydland Kotzin and with Theodore Kotzin in Chicago (see below, 1.9.3.3); she never married.

Maniek, who went to Canada, changed his name to Solow, married Dr. Hala ..., and had 2 children: Dr. Henry Solow and Guela Solow, who married Harry Ruda; they live in Toronto.

Lucia, who married David Lewin and died in the Holocaust

Madzia, who married Sol Quasha and lived in Brooklyn.

Salcia, married Adolf Frydland (son of Boris Frydland); they lived in Warsaw; Adolf died before 1914; they had 3 children, Mondzio, Zosia, and Marylka, all of whom died in the Holocaust.

Helen, married Morris (or Moses) Kotzin, and lived in Chicago. (see Morris, 1.9.3.3). She died in 1953.

Sarah Leah, married Max Hurwicz (see Max, below, 1.9.3.2)

Daughter Morissa to Israel 1961; married Elazar Amitall there in 1962; they had three children: Alon, Dekel, and Oren; they all live in Israel and have 12 children among them. Morissa is teacher/administrator at Hebrew Univ., Jerusalem.

1.9.3.2 Max Kotzin, (Mordchai or Mote), changed his surname to Hurwicz. His wife was Sarah Lea Frydland (see above, 1.9.2). They lived in Warsaw to World War I, then moved to Moscow about 1915. Max died in Moscow in 1927, Sarah Leah in 1935. They had 3 sons and 4 daughters (plus 3 children who died in infancy):

Stefan, daughter Malka and 1 other child, grandchildren Varda, Max, Arye, all in Israel.

Adek (born Warsaw 1889), wife Zeena ...; sons Leonid (Leo) and Henry (Henrik). Leo, born Moscow in 1917, moved back to Warsaw, and to the US in 1940. He married Evelyn Jensen (born Wisconsin in 1923) in 1944 in Chicago. They had 4 children: Sarah, Michael, Ruth, and Maxim. He was Professor of Economics at the University of Minnesota. He was the Nobel Prize winner in economics for 2007 for his work on mechanism design, which studies how desired outcomes are achieved, including decision-making and interactions among individuals, markets, and institutions. Leo died in Minneapolis in 2008

Mondzio (Solomon), who died in Moscow about 1923.

Doria (Dorothy), daughter Marina, grandson Max.

Rachel, daughter Gila.

Helen (Helenka), living in Moscow as of 1972, died in Minneapolis; had daughter Svetlana.

Felicia, who moved to Minneapolis, and had a daughter Masha.

1.9.3.3 Morris (Moshe Aharon), born Warsaw, married Helen (Chaya-Feigel) Frydland (later Freidlander). She was born in Lithuania in 1876 (see above). Morris went to Canada in 1912, and Helen and the children joined him in 1919; then in 1923 to Chicago; died there about 1928. Strong Zionists. 4 children, all born in Poland, probably in Kalisch (Kalisz).

Bernard (Beryl-Dov), born 1900; married to Rose Shub; his children Aviva, who married Stanley Breen (born Chicago 1930) in 1958, now in Minnesota, with son Bennett, married to Kalisma Alayon, living in New York City; and daughters Rachael, Andrea, and Jennifer; and Deena, born 1933, husband Leon Green, deceased; no children.

Theodore (Ted or Todros), born 1902, died Skokie IL in 1988.

Adolph (Avraham Abba), married Elizabeth ....; children Rhoda Hadassah, born 1933, who married Michael Harwitz in Chicago in 1957 for a short time, and lived in East Lansing MI; Moses (or Morey), born 1928, died 1946; and Charles (or Leslie Charles), born 1942, deceased.

Sol (Solomon or Shlomo), born 1906, married Ann Brickman, born Odessa, he went to Winnipeg about 1923; she to Canada 1913, to Israel 1971, he died there in 1994. 2 children:

Son Michael Kotzin, born Chicago in 1941; he married Judith Walchirk, born Chicago 1943; they went to Israel in 1968 where he became English professor; returned to US in 1979 and to Chicago in 1983; he was an executive of the Jewish United Fund/Jewish Federation of Metropolitan Chicago; children Daniel, born 1969, living in San Francisco with Jennifer Sey and son Oscar; Joshua, born 1970, married Dorian Korchmar, children Violet and Mira, live in New York; and Abigail, born 1974, married Matt Hagan, children Jonas, Penelope, and Talia, live in Oakland. Michael died in 2015 in Highland Park IL
